## KESWICK RAMBLES GUIDED MOUNTAIN WALKS

Join Keswick Rambles for Group Walks with experienced local leaders from April to October. Come and enjoy some hidden gems as well as the Lake District classics. More details of the programme are on our website [www.keswickrambles.org.uk](http://www.keswickrambles.org.uk) If you are a keen walker and enjoy the company of a small group you are sure to find kindred spirits on these walks. Individuals, couples and groups are all welcome. (and dogs!)

Book in advance with individual leaders or just turn up. Meet outside the Tourist Information Centre at the Moot Hall in Keswick Market Square. Use bus or launch to reach the start of the walk.

**Most walks start at 10am. Those marked \* have a 9am start due to bus times or due to the length of the walk. Those marked \*\* are afternoon walks with a 1pm start unless otherwise indicated**

Full day walks are from 8 to 12 miles and come in 3 categories : C - fairly easy walk on mixed ground; valleys or low fells. B - a good days walk with some steep ascents and descents; quite strenuous. A - a serious walk going high with steep ascents and descents; good fitness necessary. Half day walks are B or C grade and 4 or 5 miles

Please wear suitable clothing and footwear and bring a packed lunch and plenty of fluids. In the interest of the group as a whole the leader is empowered to refuse to take anyone whom he/she considers to be unlikely to complete the walk safely.

Charges for 2011 are £15 per adult and £7.50 per child for full day walks and half that for ½ day walks. Allow extra for bus and launch.

We are introducing a **Loyalty Card Scheme** for those of you who are regular customers, so if you come on 4 walks during 2011 you get the next one free.
